

Framework for Global Learning “Certificate”

Category	Requirement Each University can determine how many categories/items within each category are required.
Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete or test out at the end of the second year level (the equivalent of 4 semesters) • take at least two language courses at the university level
University Global Requirement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 9 hours of coursework designated as “Global” by your university or advisor • take an identified global capstone course (taken senior year)
Seminars	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • complete two global seminars prior to student teaching (1-hour each)
Class Extension/ Global Immersion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • complete at least two global class extensions (pre-approved by advisor) • complete at least two program-approved global immersion projects
Travel Abroad	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • complete at least one course-related travel abroad experience (e.g., student teaching; Ambassadors for Children; international workshop; short term study abroad, etc.)
